RECENT BIKE THEFTS

Unfortunately we've had a small but significant number of bikes stolen from the site during the past 12 months and it could be that the area is being specifically targeted.



The most recent theft was from the open bike canopy at around 10am on Sunday April 11th 2021, but previous thieves have managed to break into the lockable bike boxes.

We will continue to do all we can to prevent any further thefts and to help with any investigations, but would remind residents that all bikes are left on site at the owners risk and should be checked regularly.

Please note that we have recently relocated one of the CCTV cameras to provide better coverage of the area in question and we have also added some additional lighting.

Residents should make sure that if their bicycle is left under the shed canopy or in one of the bike boxes it has a good quality lock to deter any theft and sufficient insurance to cover its loss. Otherwise bicycles must be kept inside residents' flats and not left in the communal halls and landings.

Under no circumstances should residents place themselves in any danger, but if they witness any theft in progress they should call the police, and report any other suspicious or unusual activity on the site to Peter Collier at Faraday and/or to Gary the on-site porter.

Any comments or practical suggestions on this matter would be welcomed.
